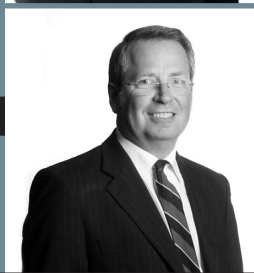
Ginnette Fitzharris
