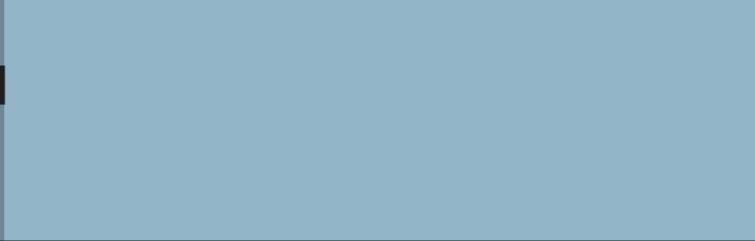
Clare Porter-Phillips
